

NOTICE OF MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to the qualified voters of Black Creek, Elm City, Lucama, Saratoga, Sharpsburg, Sims, Stantonsburg, Kenly, and the City of Wilson Mayor and City Council Districts 1, 2 & 4 that Municipal Elections will be held Tuesday, November 5, 2019.

The polls for said election will be open from 6:30 a.m. until 7:30 p.m.

All municipal voters registered with the Wilson County Board of Elections that reside in the above named municipalities are eligible to vote in this election.

Voters who are already registered to vote need not re-register. Residents who are not registered to vote or those registered that need to make changes must do so by Friday, October 11, 2019, to be eligible to vote in this election or register and vote during the one-stop period. Request for voter registration application forms may be made from the Wilson County Board of Elections office, 112 Douglas St. E., between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. each Monday through Friday, and the Wilson County Public Library, 249 W. Nash St., Wilson, N. C., during regular hours. Application forms may also be obtained from the Town Halls in Black Creek, Elm City, Kenly, Lucama, Saratoga, Sharpsburg, Sims, and Stantonsburg during their office hours.

Any qualified voter may vote by absentee ballot. The voter may apply for an absentee ballot beginning Friday October 4, 2019. The deadline for applying for an absentee ballot to be mailed to the voter is 5:00 p.m., Tuesday, October 29, 2019. The Board of Elections will meet at 5:00 p.m. October 15, October 22, October 29, November 4, November 5 and other times as may be necessary for the purpose of approving absentee ballot applications. Counting of absentee ballots will begin at 5:00 pm November 5.

One-stop voting will be held in the Board of Elections office beginning October 16, 2019, Hours are: 8:00 am until 5:00 pm Monday through Friday, and 8:00 am until 5:00 pm Saturday, October 26, 2019 and One-stop voting ends at 5:00 pm November 1, 2019.

Canvass will be at 11:00 a.m. November 15, 2019 in the Board of Elections office.
